Traffic Management Scheme

The final draft of the traffic management scheme consisting of "H" markings, double yellow lines and bus stop road markings has been produced. Public consultation will take place in the Parish Rooms on Thursday 19th August, 3pm to 6pm. This is a drop in session. Members of the public will be able to view the planned road markings and make comment. A member from BMBC Highways will be present to answer any questions.

Green bin collection

Green bin collection has now resumed.

Overhanging vegetation

Please could residents check that vegetation from their garden is not overhanging the public footpaths making it difficult for members of the public to pass.

Cars parking on the footpath

In some areas of the village cars have been parking on the footpath causing an obstruction. If a car is parked on the footpath and is blocking the footpath making it impossible for wheelchair users and pushchairs to pass, you can report it. If the car is parked on a yellow line or where a kerb is dropped, report it to BMBC via their website. BMBC cannot take action if there is no yellow line. In these cases report it to the police by phoning 101.

New litter bin

The Parish Council has purchased a new general purpose public litter bin for Dark Lane to replace the dog litter bin which was continually overflowing with general rubbish.

Neighbourhood Plan

The Neighbourhood Plan was made (adopted) by BMBC on 14th July.

Norcroft Pit Disaster Memorial Committee

The Parish Council has awarded a grant to the Norcroft Memorial Committee towards the purchase of an information board which is to be sited on Norcroft Lane near to the site of the pit.
