Heritage Assets

The Parish Council is still looking for people to help with submitting Cawthorne's Heritage Assets for inclusion on the South Yorkshire Heritage Asset List.

The South Yorkshire Archaeology Services are wanting to create a South Yorkshire Heritage Asset List., a list of locally significant heritage assets (buildings, monuments, archaeological sites and parks and gardens) to help protect what makes our local areas distinctive and special. The Cawthorne Neighbourhood Plan

has already identified many Local Heritage Assets and it is intended that these are added to the South Yorkshire List. Nominations for inclusion on the list can be from individuals or from groups. The Parish Council wants to set up a working party to take on the task of nominating the assets listed in the Neighbourhood Plan, and any others that residents think should be included.
