Burglaries in Cawthorne

The Parish Council contacted South Yorkshire Police to see if an open meeting could be arranged. It received this reply:-

“Following the recent spate of burglaries in the Cawthorne area, the police are actively working with other forces to try to identify nominals who they suspect are travelling into our Force area to commit these burglaries. There is a lot of work going on behind the scenes that we cannot divulge at this time. However, please be reassured that we are doing everything we can to prevent these burglaries from occurring.

Unfortunately at this moment in time, the Penistone Community Police Team have been unable to oblige with a meeting due to the high demand of Tasking.
