### **Grant to Cawthorne Toddler and Baby Group**

The Parish Council has awarded a grant to Cawthorne Toddler and Baby Group for a new advertisement banner and some new play tents.

### **Cemetery and Churchyard Tidy-up**

The next cemetery/churchyard tidy-up has been arranged for Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> April. Meet at the Parish Room at 10am. All welcome.

### **Litter Bins**

The public litter bins should be emptied by BMBC weekly on a Tuesday. Or you can report it to the Cawthorne Parish Council Clerk who will report it to BMBC.

### **Dog litter bin**

The Parish Council has successfully requested that the dog litter bin situated at the junction of Lane Head Road and Church Street, near the wall, be moved as it had become inaccessible due to the overgrowing vegetation. The bin is now further away from the wall on the grass verge.

### **Footpaths**

A footpath bridge over Tanyard Back at the rear of Naylor's has been replaced as it had become unsafe. The single step stile on the footpath that runs from South Lane

to Lane Head Road was wobbly and has been replaced with a two step timber stile. The footpath finger post on Dark Lane near the cricket ground has been replaced as its base had rotted. Thanks to BMBC's Public Rights of Way for carrying out these works.

The Annual meeting of the Parish will take place on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April at approximately 7.45 pm in the Moxon Room of Cawthorne Village Hall.
