Annual Meeting of the Council

The Parish Council meeting on Thursday 5th May was the Annual Meeting, the first meeting of the new council year.

Cemetery Tidy Up

Many thanks to all who turned out on 7th May to the Cemetery Tidy up; 10 parishioners, two from Exodus charity, 4 councillors, the clerk to the council and two from Twiggs/Penistone Clean and Tidy Group. Several graves adjacent the church wall had been completely covered in ivy; this was removed to reveal the graves for the first time in years. Some of the older headstones in the cemetery likewise were completely or very nearly completely covered in ivy and this was also removed. Numerous bags of ivy were removed from site. There are still some graves yet to clear so another session may be organised later in the year.
