Cawthorne TRO

The Traffic Regulation Order for Cawthorne which involves the installation of double yellow lines, bus stop markings and new, extended and repainted 'H' markings is now out to consultation by BMBC. See the notices placed on lamp posts around the village near the affected areas of Church Street, Darton Road, Tivydale and The Park for details of how to view and comment on the plans.

Dogs

Whilst the majority of dog owners are thoughtful and take care that their dog behaves when in public, unfortunately there are some who are not.

Recently there was an upsetting incident when a dog attacked a cat leaving it very badly wounded. There is also an increase in the amount of dog poo being left on public footpaths.

Please would all owners keep their dog on a lead whilst walking in the village and clean up after the dog.

5G Telecommunications mast

BMBC have refused planning permission for the 20m high telecommunications mast. In their opinion the development would be a prominent and discordant feature in the street scene which would materially harm the visual amenities of the locality by virtue of its siting and appearance and would have a detrimental impact on the character and setting of the Cawthorne Conservation Area. The height of the structure, combined with the bulk of the antenna head, would make it an overly dominant feature in the residential surroundings. The proposal is therefore contrary to Local Plan policies HE1 The Historic Environment, D1 High Quality Design and Place Making and GD1 General

Development and Policy C7 of the Cawthorne Neighbourhood Development Plan.

Covid Memorial in Barnsley

A bronze sculpture which commemorates those who have died during the pandemic and pays tribute to key workers and volunteers will be unveiled later this month.

The artwork will be unveiled on Monday November 22 at 1.15pm in The Glass Works Square Barnsley. Residents are welcome to attend the open-air event which commences at 1.15pm with public viewing of the sculpture and the exhibition in the new Barnsley Museums Gallery@ The Glass Works will be available from 2:30pm.
