Traffic Management Scheme

Following the public meeting held in the Parish Room in August, the draft proposal for a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) (plans for installation of double yellow lines, 'H' markings etc.) has been amended by BMBC to take into account comments made by the members of the public. This amended TRO is being scrutinised by BMBC's legal department and will be put out to public consultation after that. We have no date yet for this consultation.

Thank you to everyone in the village who turned out to the meeting in August and to those who could not make the meeting but gave comment.

Norcroft Pit Disaster Memorial

Councillors and the Clerk attended the unveiling of the Norcroft Pit Disaster Memorial board on Norcroft Lane. The board gives information on the pit and the disaster and also details of a circular walk taking in the sites of various local mining pits.

The Parish Council had given a grant towards this project.

School Trim Trail

The school has a new Trim Trail. The Parish Council had given grants to the Parents Association towards this project

Planning application for a 5G mast

The Parish Council objects to the erection of the 5G mast on Lane Head Road, Cawthorne on the grounds of visual amenity and the closeness to dwellings. It appreciates that a 5G mast is needed to improve internet connectivity but considers that the site as in the application is not appropriate. It suggests that a site on the opposite side of the road away from the village might be a better location.

Paper containers with metal ends now accepted at Barnsley Household Waste Recycling Centres

From now on residents can take paper containers with metal ends such as Pringles tubes, hot chocolate, nuts and other products to any Barnsley Household Waste Recycling Centre to be recycled alongside food and drink cartons. Anyone unable to do this should continue to put this type of packaging in their grey bin. The brown bin is for food tins, foil trays and drinks cans, mixed glass bottles and jars, and plastic bottles only. The blue bin is for clean and dry paper and cardboard only.

5 on the Farm
