**Cllr Barron:** (i) Vegetation on the approach to Kexborough Bridge has not yet been cut back (ii) there is a lot of decaying leaf mould on Church Walk (iii) could the Parish Clerk write to the estate agents asking them to remove the boards (iv) cars are being parked in the bus bays

**Cllr Walker:** the school is concerned about traffic speeding down Tivydale.

**Cllr Kilner:** an electricity pole in a field opposite Naylor's has had a red banner on stating "danger" for some time, could the clerk write to Northern Power to find out what is happening

**Cllr Wilson:** dog fouling throughout the village

**Cllr Eyre:** (i) as a result of a tree blowing over onto Tivydale during high winds, could the Parish Clerk write to certain houses recommending that they have their trees surveyed for safety. There followed some debate as to whether this was in the remit of a parish council. The Clerk to seek advice from YLCA before writing (ii) holly bushes have been planted on the grass area by the grindstone in The Park by person unknown.
