Freedom of the Parish

At a special event on 17th August, Robert Barr of Cinderhill Farm was given the Freedom of the Parish of Cawthorne by Cawthorne Parish Council.

Granting the Freedom of the Parish is the highest honour that the Parish Council can bestow. Although it carries no powers, rights or privileges, those who receive the honour are able to use the title of Freeman.

In 2009 legislation was amended so that Town and Parish Councils can admit Honorary

Freeman, before then it was exclusive to cities and boroughs. Robert is only the second person to be made a Freeman of the Parish of Cawthorne, the first being Eric Ellis in 2010.

Robert had served on the parish council for over forty years, renowned for his passion in preserving the historical character of the village and its flora and fauna. He has been a trustee of the Cawthorne Recreation Ground and Cawthorne 'Old Number 10' club for many years and was on the working group for the Parks for People project renovations at Cannon Hall Park.

Robert was presented with an Honorary Freeman of the Parish scroll by Professor Dame Hilary Chapman, Lord-Lieutenant of South Yorkshire. The event was attended by councillors and family and friends of Robert.

Robert retired from the parish council in May.
