- A cracked grate in the grave yard would need replacing – Cllr Herbert was to have a look to see if he had a spare on hand.
- It was decided to do a list for the notice board – rules and regulations etc
- The working party would clear out the wall of ivy
- The lamp in the graveyard is compromised – Cllr Walker was to ask about this at the church meeting.
- Jason Sanger would be asked to look at the lime tree
- There was a bush next to the little door at the back of the church that needed maintaining – This would be taken care of at the next grave yard tidy up.
- Jason Sanger would be asked to look at the yew tree.
- Cllr Eyre agreed to walk Jason Sanger round and show what jobs needed
- Clerk to obtain more quotes for the maintenance still required.
