Cllr Eyre mentioned that there had been a dead bird seen on 'The Park' and expressed it needed removing due to bird flu. The clerk will get in touch with the relevant place to remove.

Cllr eyre reported that there had been two ad-blue containers on the bypass that looked as if they had just been thrown out of a window. He asked if a litter pick could be arranged for some time in March – the clerk will follow this up.

Cllr Broadhead mentioned the potholes entering the village on Church Lane just before Gallery 2 and asked that the clerk report these.

Cllr Rusby reported that there was to be some firearms training for South Yorkshire Police on different dates using Cawthorne Recreation Grounds in early 2026.
