Minute No 178 TO RECEIVE QUESTIONS CONCERNS FROM THE PUBLIC

Residents attended the Full Council meeting to raise concerns about parking problems on "The Park," particularly on Sundays when Junior Football matches are held.

They made it clear that they support the football club and are not objecting to its presence. However, they are experiencing significant difficulties caused by matchday parking. These include:

- Residents being blocked from getting on or off their driveways
- Visitors being unable to access the street
- General congestion in the area
- Instances of abusive behaviour when drivers are asked to move their vehicles.

Gemma Mooney, Secretary of Cawthorne Junior Football Club, provided an overview of the club and explained the measures currently in place to help reduce parking issues.

It was agreed during the meeting that the main issue is that the facility does not have sufficient parking to accommodate the number of vehicles on match days. Additional parking provision was identified as a potential solution.

The Parish Council agreed to contact the appropriate authorities to explore possible solutions.
